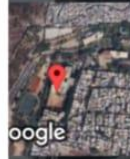

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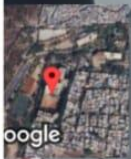
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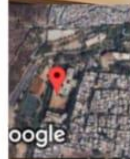

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and focus proved particularly effective, as students learned how to apply these techniques in real-world scenarios.




**Interactive and Practical Approach:**
