These inspiring series aim to motivate young minds by showcasing how challenges can be transformed into opportunities through the experiences of Indian leaders and startup founders.

The episode of "Rashtra Pratham" was broadcast on 11th July 2025 at 11:30 AM, In this insightful episode, Mr. Mayank Bidawatka, the Co-founder of Koo, participates in an open and thought-provoking conversation with Dr. Abhay Jere, the Vice Chairman of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE). The discussion centers on Mayank's entrepreneurial journey, offering a behind-the-scenes look into the realities of building a startup in India.

The conversation explores both **successes and struggles**—from national recognition during the "Vocal for Local" movement to challenges like market competition, funding constraints, and policy barriers. Mr. Bidawatka emphasizes how **failures and setbacks shaped his resilience**, **leadership**, **and adaptability**.

The episode concludes with actionable advice for aspiring entrepreneurs: embrace failure, solve real-world problems, stay patient and persistent, and approach entrepreneurship with purpose rather than glamour.
