


Brief report /Description on the event

Stray animals have become a significant concern in urban and semi-urban areas, creating challenges for public safety, hygiene, and smooth daily life. The session highlights the need for coordinated efforts involving local authorities, communities, and animal welfare organizations to ensure both human safety and animal welfare.

As per the DTE circular no 2025/4530 dated 19th December 2025 awareness session on Preventing Nuisance Caused by Stray Animals in Daily Human Life was conducted at IMERT. The event began with a welcome address by the Nodal Officer Prof Pranjal Jadhav, who explained the purpose of the program. Resource persons Prof Aparna Shastri, Mr Vyankatesh Kakade, Mr Vivek Sawant spoke about the increasing presence of stray animals such as cattle and dogs on roads and in residential areas. They discussed causes such as abandonment, lack of shelters, and weak enforcement of regulations. Visual aids, real-life examples, were used to explain how stray animals contribute to traffic accidents, congestion, unhygienic conditions, and fear among citizens. Audio Visual was shown for more information. The event was successful in creating awareness and encouraging responsible behaviour among students.

		
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
