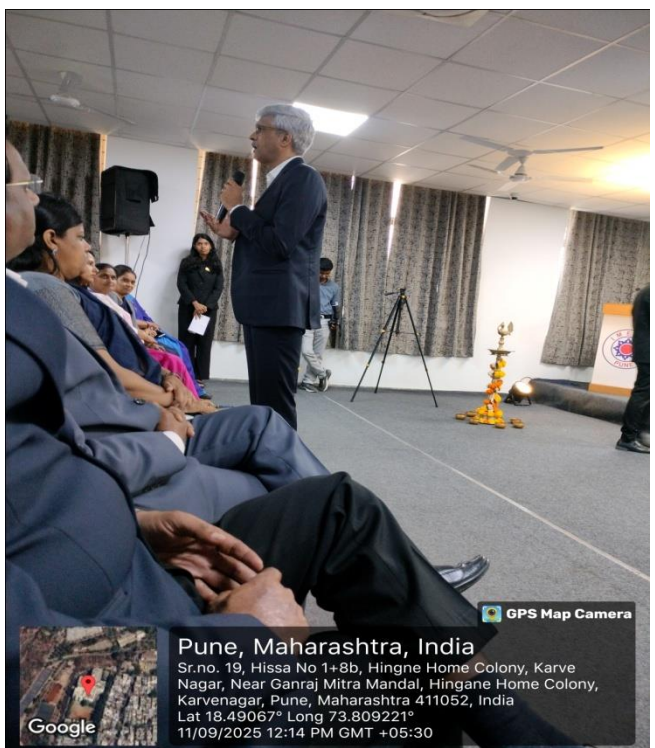

Week 1 – 4th September to 12th September, 2025 - Sessions:

The three-week MBA Induction Program of Marathwada Mitra Mandal Group and Institute of Management Education, Research and Training (MM's IMERT) was conducted from 4th September to 26th September, 2025. It included many interactive, skill-based activities and group tasks, for the newly inducted students to gel among themselves and their seniors. The program included outdoor management training through the team games, as well as the value addition activities, lectures and the foundation courses, to create the base for fresh graduate learners.

A pre-induction onboarding program was conducted on 4th September 2025. The **Director of IMERT Dr. Shubhangee Ramaswamy** addressed the students. She welcomed newly admitted students and briefly introduced the Marathwada Mitra Mandal Group and IMERT and its legacy. Madam emphasized the need and importance of understanding the institutional culture and how it can be supportive to the students in achieving their career goals at the end of the MBA program and even after that.

Pre-induction on boarding, Welcome Note and Virtual Campus Tour took for the new students was conducted by **Prof. Vivek Dighe**. In the next session **Prof. Pranjal Jadhav** and **Prof. Aparna Shastri** acquainted the new admitted students to the **Mentoring System at IMERT**. She explained in detail the importance of mentoring system and its benefits to the student. She also emphasized the attendance monitoring and close follow up of placement training activities. After this **Dr. Praful Sarangdhar** provided the information about **Avishkar Competition** for students, where participating students can present their hands on training projects completed. **Prof. Aparna Shastri** briefed the students about the activities conducted under the **Institutional Social Responsibilities (ISR)** each year by IMERT students and staff. She explained the importance of such activities and appealed all present to take part in the same.

During the second half of the day second year students planned the **'Teachers Day'** celebrations. Students expressed their gratitude towards the teaching faculties. The speaker students expressed their gratitude towards the teacher and talked about the Indian traditions regarding the Guru Purnima.

On Thursday, 11th September, 2025, the **32nd MBA Induction Inauguration function** of IMERT, took place in the seminar hall at the campus. **Mr. Shrikant Sarda, M.D. Accenture** was the chief guest and **Mr. Shirish Kulkarni, Certified Independent Director – STROTA Consulatech** was the guest of honour for the induction program. **Mrs. Aditi Ganage – Dy. Director, Corporate Relation Division at Marathwada Mitra Mandal** and **Dr. Shubhangee Ramaswamy, Director – IMERT** were present. **The program was organized with the guidance and support from Hon. Principal B.G. Jadhav – executive president of Marathwada Mitra Mandal Trust.**

Mr. Shrikant Sarda emphasised the importance of continuous learning, getting out of comfort zone, and being aware. He advised students to make one-year goals and commit to achieve the same. He also mentioned the ethics, integrity and mental wellness as essentials for the success in the VUCA world.

Mr. Shirish Kulkarni Shared the digital and technological advances, opportunities and the possible competencies required to meet the future challenges. He expressed the opinion that technology can create the challenges but it will not be a threat. He said that students must nurture their unique personal expression, be ahead of the curve in adapting, be relevant and interested.

Dr. Shubhangee Ramaswamy informed the gathering about prestigious heritage of the Marathwada Mitra Mandal group, Unique Culture, Strategic Industrial Linkages, affiliations and tie-ups of the IMERT for student's capability building, and impressive rankings and awards received in the recent year. She particularly mentioned the Green Ranking award by Sustainable Institution of India and the STEM ranking which is indication of transformative teaching and research practices, capable of shaping future innovators and the leaders. She expressed the confidence that with various platforms,

state of the art infrastructure and robust teaching learning ecosystem students can build their successful careers after leaving the IMERT.

In the afternoon session, **Ms. Pooja Baghel** Law expert conducted a session of **Anti-Ragging Awareness**. She highlighting the legal framework and institutional policies that promote student safety. Through real-life examples, she demonstrated the emotional and legal consequences of ragging. She emphasized empathy, respect, and accountability — urging students to build a culture of inclusivity and dignity on campus. The session fostered awareness and responsibility among the new entrants.

Mr Dhaval Patil, Talent Executive Xoriant conducted a session on **'From Speculation Choice to career readiness alumni perspective on profile building and expectations**. He shared the experiences from his own professional journey till date and the importance of management mindset developed during the education years as well as learning from the experience.

On the day three, **Ms. Swapna Bamane of HR Business Partner, Infrabeat Technologies Pune** focused on **"Employment Skills for the Future: Soft, Hard, and AI-Driven."** She explained how in the modern workplace hybrid professionals can merge human intelligence with technological tools. Students learned the importance of emotional intelligence, adaptability, and lifelong learning to remain industry-relevant. The session reinforced the idea that success lies in balancing technical proficiency with interpersonal grace. The second session was **" Public Speaking and Corporate Etiquettes" by Ms. Anima Jain-Vice President-HR, Innovative Techhub Pvt. Ltd.**

She delivered an engaging talk on effective communication and professional behaviour in corporate life. She explained the art of public speaking, confident body language, and corporate etiquette, highlighting how professionalism in conduct shapes one's career trajectory. Through mock introductions and practical examples, students learned the essence of confidence, courtesy, and corporate polish.

The third session **Session on " Mindset matters from Campus to Corporate" by Mrs Madhuri Kotak- Bagul , Sr Director Sakon- Managed & Professional Services.** Mrs. Madhuri Kotak-Bagul's inspiring session focused on developing a growth-oriented and resilient mindset as students transition from academics to the corporate world. She emphasized accountability, adaptability, and time management as essential attributes. Her anecdotes encouraged students to think positively, embrace challenges, and evolve into professionals who lead with integrity and purpose.

In the second half of the day, **Mr. Deepak Dorik, Certified Trainer – Behavior-Based Safety,** conducted a Session on **"Disaster Management"**. He introduced students to the fundamentals of Disaster Management and Behavioral-Based Safety (BBS). He explained the significance of preparedness, teamwork, and calm leadership during emergencies. The session provided practical insights into organizational safety systems and the behavioural aspects that reduce risks. Students were encouraged to adopt a safety-first mindset as a hallmark of responsible management.

Week 2 – 15th September to 19th September, 2025 - Sessions:

On Monday, 15th September Session on **"Personal Grooming"** was conducted by **Ms Shweta Parekh, Head HR, Flentas**. This session on Personal Grooming underscored the connection between appearance, confidence, and professionalism. She elaborated on workplace attire, hygiene, and demeanour, stressing that personal grooming reflects self-discipline and respect. Students were guided on dressing for different corporate occasions, maintaining digital professionalism, and creating a lasting first impression.

Prof Pranjal Jadhav conducted **Orientation on Pre-Assessment** test that takes place during the induction.

After the break a session on **Water Conservation by Ms. Mrinal Vaidya, Mula River Aundh Ghat Coordinator**, was planned. The session highlighted the urgency of sustainable water management and civic participation. Sharing her work in river restoration, she inspired students to view environmental sustainability as both a personal duty and a professional responsibility. The discussion linked conservation efforts with Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), encouraging eco-conscious leadership. The session was also supported by **Mr. Adish Barve Mutha river, Vitthalwadi coordinator, jeevitnadi living River foundation**.

16th September 2025

An Orientation on **"E- Library Resource" CMIE by Ms Kranti Patil - Mr Satish Patil & student Volunteers** was planned on Tuesday. He introduced the e-sources in the form of data bases available at library, and the e-learning facilities in the form of subscriptions to various magazines and Journals etc. was updated.

The second Session was on **" Email Writing" by Hirai Desai, Corporate Trainer – Communication Skills**. She conducted a practical workshop on Email Writing, focusing on clarity, tone, and etiquette in corporate correspondence. Students learned the structure of formal emails, the importance of proofreading, and how to convey professionalism through concise communication. The exercises helped participants develop confidence in digital communication, a critical employability skill in today's workplace.

An after-lunch Session on **Self-Leadership** was conducted by **Mr. Abhishek Kulkarni, Head – People & Organization, Umicore Group**. The program culminated with an introspective session by Mr. Abhishek Kulkarni on Self-Leadership. He explained that effective leadership begins with self-awareness, discipline, and consistency. Through engaging discussions, he encouraged students to reflect on their personal skill set and the domain knowledge base.

Mr Shubham of Edulife, conducted the next session. IMERT uses an ERP software for the teaching learning as well as the Placement activities (POD). The session informed about the usefulness and things to do for updating the personal information and searching best leads.

On 17th September 2025, the first session was by **Ms Bhagyashree Kartre** titled **"Alumni Interaction."** IMERT has an alumni Association, that actively conducts the sessions for students giving the updates of industry. She informed the students about the various opportunities in the industry, how to hunt for the best jobs etc. Prof. Dnyaneshwar Unawane conducted the Orientation session on Placement Cell. IMERT has a special platform POD for the placement related activities. Where various company HR can see the students' profiles and skill sets.

Introduction to CBCS (Choice based Credit System) & Evaluation session in the NEP 2024 Pattern was conducted by Prof. Sachin Kshirsagar. He explained the syllabus, evaluation framework and experiential learning opportunities present for the students.

Dr Ravi Achaliya conducted a specialized training session on **MS Word and PowerPoint workshop**, aimed to equip students with advanced proficiency in these essential tools, fostering skills critical for academic excellence and professional growth. In an era increasingly dominated by AI and automation,

tools like MS Word and PowerPoint continue to hold immense importance. While AI tools can generate content and design templates, human expertise remains irreplaceable in tailoring and refining content to suit specific contexts. The trainer emphasized the growing demand for individual's adept at combining these tools with AI capabilities to enhance productivity and creativity. This session highlighted how mastering these tools can complement AI technologies and give students a competitive edge. The training received an overwhelmingly positive response from participants, who appreciated the interactive teaching style and hands-on exercises. Students actively engaged in practice sessions, clarifying doubts and showcasing creativity in the assignments.

Foundation course on "**Basics of Accounting - Finance for Non-Finance**" was conducted by **Dr Mangalgauri Patil**. As many students enrolling for MBA are from no Finance background it is essential to update their accounts and finance basics. The foundation course is aimed at bringing those students up to date with the commerce background students.

On 18th September, a session was organized by **Ms. Dhanashree Ghare, student counsellor**, regarding the **Mental Health**. a session. She is a counsellor, teacher and most importantly a change agent. With her wide experience in Industry and academia she has counselled hundreds of students. She shared that the emotional resilience and toughness is, required for facing the tough situation in the work environment and it can be stressful. She advised students as to how to behave, maintain correct attitude and how habits and small things matter. She emphasised upon our culture and value system being helpful.

A second session on **DELNET** was planned by **Mr. Rathod**. **DELNET (Developing Library Network) is South Asia's largest resource-sharing library network**, connecting over 9,000 institutions (universities, research centres, etc.) in India and abroad to facilitate access to vast collections of books, journals, articles, and other digital resources. It provides crucial services like Inter-Library Loan (ILL) and Document Delivery, enabling users to find and borrow materials from other member libraries, significantly supporting academics and research by pooling information resources. This facility is availed by the institute for our students.

Week 3– 23rd September to 26th September, 2025 - The session on "E- Library Resource" **EBSCO** by **Mr. Satish Patil**, was planned on the 23rd September first half. He informed the students about various library resources available for the student's research projects like Field Work, On the Job Training, etc. These resources are paid for the Institute and are available for searching collecting and using various data that is required for the research paper writing.

The second session was on "**Leadership and Emotional Intelligence**" by **Mr. Girish Konkar**. For any leader emotional intelligence is very important. Mr Konkar explained the basics of emotional intelligence. He has a wider experience and shared the situational use of the emotional intelligence and how it can lead to success. He explained the managerial responsibilities and how emotional intelligence plays a significant role in meeting the challenges in the competitive world.

In the second half of the day **Mr Amol Dede** conducted a session on **Self Defense**. With his assistants and the volunteers, he demonstrated how to defend oneself in the violent situation. The methods focused on the self-defense technique to be used with out any accessories against an advancing person. The techniques he demonstrated were simple and can be used by the girl students also.

As per the guidelines of AICTE, **Foundation Courses** are included as a part of the Induction Program. During the second and third week of the induction students attend the sessions on **Basic Accounting and Finance for Non Finance**. This helps the non-commerce back ground students to catch up to the other students. Institute faculties conduct these sessions which prove very useful as gathered from the students feedback as well as the faculty experience.

On the Wednesday, 23rd September **Prof Aparna Shastri filled the Ant ragging Form** from the students and **Dr Praful Sarangdhar** conducted a Session on **Student Council**. At IMERT student council, placement cell and other forms of opportunities are available to the students for managing and experiencing the formal working and interaction with other students and the industry officials in a formal way. Students are also expected to behave and conducted themselves in a just way. IMERT works on the zero tolerance principle and it is made known to the students during the induction program.

The post lunch sessions included "Personal Grooming" by Dr Sheetal Kazi , CEO- Phoenix Training & Placement Consultancy Services

A Session on **Entrepreneurship Development** was conducted on 25th September by **Prof Vivekanand Gaikwad**. IMERT has an **Incubation Centre** in campus, where students can approach for all possible help they may need for starting their own business. Many startups are already registered there and Institute encourages the aspiring students to avail the facility of the ecosystem that is available for them. Some past students of the Institute are part of this centre.

Post lunch a session on "**Internal Complaint Committee**" was conducted by **Ms. Mrunal Patel**. This is one of the statutory committees. The students are acquainted with the form and purpose of the committee and informed as to how they can avail the help, if case it is needed.

A Session "**Role of youth on Nation Building**" under **Indian Knowlegde System** was planned by **Ms Gunakshi Dhanegaokar**. Our ethos and traditional knowledge along with the rich cultural heritage is unequal in the world. The students were sensitized to the fact of usefulness and the wisdom of following selectively the relevant part of our heritage and consciously guarding against the harmful practices of blindly following the unwanted influences in the today's world.
