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

Event Report

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's Institute of Management Education Research and Training (MM's IMERT) organized a Half-day Seminar on Union Budget 2026–27: Strategic Analysis for Future Managers under the guidance of Dr. Shubhangee Ramaswamy, Director. The expert session was conducted by CA Chirag Sancheti. The seminar was organized for MBA-I (Sem II) and MBA-II (Sem IV) students with the objective of providing a comprehensive understanding of the Union Budget and its strategic implications for future managers.

The session began with an overview of key taxation reforms, focusing on changes in TDS provisions and revised income tax slabs, helping students understand their impact on individuals and businesses. The discussion further covered GST updates, including the concept of GST 2.0, rationalization of tax rates, and its implications on different sectors of the economy. Special emphasis was given to government initiatives supporting start-ups, including various schemes and incentives designed to promote entrepreneurship, along with insights into tax benefits under Section 80 IAC, often referred to as a "tax haven" for eligible start-ups.

The resource person also explained specialization-wise reforms introduced in the budget, highlighting implications for Finance, Marketing, HR, and Operations domains, thereby enabling students to connect policy decisions with managerial functions. The session concluded with a discussion on probable interview questions related to the Union Budget, equipping students with practical knowledge and confidence for placements.

Overall, the seminar was highly informative and provided valuable insights into the Union Budget 2026–27, enhancing students' analytical and strategic thinking skills.
