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Objectives of the Activity:

1. To orient MBA Batch (2025–27) students about the Placement Training Program and its significance in enhancing employability.
2. To familiarize students with the various training modules, certification programs, and placement preparation activities planned during the academic year.
3. To create awareness about the skills, competencies, and professional expectations of recruiters.
4. To motivate students to actively participate in all training sessions and prepare themselves for successful campus placements.

Outcomes of the Activity:
